 - Rangers located three missing persons including two children
 - Rangers arrested a subject for auto theft after a foot pursuit, car recovered along Dry Creek Parkway
 - Rangers arrested a person for evading arrest and unlicensed driver after a short vehicle pursuit-upper portion of American River Parkway
 - Rangers recovered handgun parts by Bannon Island, ARP, which were reported stolen out of Elk Grove
 - Rangers found a razor blade stuck in a park bench at William Pond (ARP), an investigation continues.
 - Rangers recovered three stolen bicycles (arrests made in two cases and warrant requested in third case).
 - Rangers investigated an assault with a deadly weapon at Harrington Access (ARP), and arrested the suspect
 - Rangers investigated a stolen cell phone report at Sunrise Access (ARP) and arrested the responsible
 - Rangers investigated two separate stabbings on 3-23-2017. One at Del Paso Blvd and the second at Ethan Way (both on ARP). Arrest made on the Ethan Way case.
 - Rangers investigating an exhibition of speed complaint at Sunrise Ave access, driver fled in his vehicle and crashed on Sunrise Ave. Driver was arrested after a foot pursuit for various crimes including evading arrest and driving under the influence.
 - Rangers responded to Sailor Bar (ARP) on a sexual assault report, case turned over to Sacramento Sheriff.
 - During a warrant arrest at Riverbend Park (ARP), a Ranger was assaulted by the suspect during the arrest.

- Rangers investigated a missing kayaker by Riverbend Park. Sacramento Sheriff Helicopter crew located the individual stranded on an island after his boat capsized.
