The parade will start promptly at 2PM.

The registration area is in the front parking lot at the Dillard School. Once you have checked in and have your number, all animals please proceed to the back parking lot for line up and preparations, all vehicles are free to park in the front lot, out of the way. The parade route starts at the Dillard School on Dillard Road, proceeds to the Wilton Fire Station and turns onto Wilton Road, The Announcer is posted at the Viewing Station near the **Dillard Store**, the parade ends at the Post Office **or Gaye Rd for children/walking groups**. The distance is about a mile and a half.

Parade Categories: Walking Group, Mounted Group, Vehicle, Animals, Float, **Buggy**/Cart or Other.

# PARADE ETIQUETTE

IS MERELY COMMON SENSE AND COMMON **COURTESY**

1. Be on time- set up and be waiting for parade to start 15 minutes before start time.
2. During the parade, Be “On Stage” You are going to have a good time. So, wave, smile and talk to the crowd while walking the route.
3. You must allow 12-15 feet between you and the group in front of you and behind you! **DO NOT BUNCH UP ON PARADE ROUTE.**
4. You must allow 20 feet between you and the group **at** the Viewing Station, for the Announcer and to properly present and view each group. Do not proceed into viewing area until the group ahead of you is completely exited.
5. .You need to bring Safety Pins, clear tape or something to secure your number to your group or vehicle. This number needs to be on the left side of the group or vehicle, for the judges and announcer to identify you.
6. Keep in mind **that** the animals in the parade **are in an** unfamiliar environment. Parades have: Bands, Flags, Balloons, Fire Engines, Floats and a constantly moving crowd, all an unfamiliar scene. Be patient with your animals.
7. If you start the parade you are expected to complete the parade route. If your vehicle breaks down pull to the side watching for the crowd.
8. If you have a trailer for your animals or vehicle, you will need to park the “Rig” in the parking lot and return there after the parade. The road will be closed for two (2) hours for the parade for loading up after in the Parking Lot. The road is opened up after the end of the parade
