- **Sacramento County 311 connect reports-35reports**

- Regional Parks has now merged the Oak Leaf reporting system with Sacramento County 311 connect. This system allows for better tracking of issues reported by citizens visiting the regional parks
- We received 35 reports in the month of September with the most frequently reported issue being illegal camping with 20 reports. The second most reported situation involved park maintenance issues with 6.
- The remaining 9 reports were for garbage in the American River Parkway, speeding bikes, people going through dumpsters, gas powered bikes on the American River Parkway, and 1 crime related problem.
